

PATROL HOURS & COMPETITION REQUIRMENTS

The Ellis Beach SLSC patrol members must complete their patrol hours to be eligible to compete at any NQ Branch Carnivals.

I'd like to stress the point this year that surf sports (i.e. carnivals) are for active members of the Ellis Beach SLSC. I repeat active members. This means that if you **don't** do your patrols throughout the season, The Ellis Beach SLSC may not allow you to register for a carnival. You must do a minimum number of hours to register for each carnival. As per table below:

Etty Bay	14 & 15 Aug 2010	16
Ellis Beach	28 & 29 Aug 2010	16
Cairns	18 & 19 Sept 2010	20
Port Douglas (NQ Branch)	16 & 17 Oct 2010	25
North Australian Champs (Mackay)	29 & 30 Oct 2010	25

The NQ Branch Championships and the North Australian Championships are 25 hours as they are controlled under the Surf Life Saving Queensland Policy. For new members these hours are calculated on a pro rata bases.

If you do not comply with these hours you may not be nominated in that carnival.
